Theme: Trusting God and Walking in His Wisdom

Key Verse

"Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." — Proverbs 3:5-6 (KJV)

Overview

Proverbs 3 teaches us how to live a life that honors God through trust, wisdom, humility, and obedience. Solomon reminds us that God's wisdom is far greater than our own understanding and that His guidance brings peace and direction.

Main Lessons

1. Trust God Completely (Verses 5-6)

God calls us to trust Him with every part of our lives, even when we don't understand His plan.

2. Honor God First (Verses 9-10)

We honor Him by putting Him first in our finances, our time, and our daily decisions.

3. Accept God's Correction (Verses 11-12)

God disciplines those He loves and helps us grow spiritually.

4. Seek God's Wisdom (Verses 13-26)

Wisdom is more valuable than riches and brings peace, stability, and guidance.

5. Treat Others with Kindness (Verses 27-35)

Help those in need, live honestly, avoid conflict, and walk in humility.

Application

- Am I trusting God with all my heart?
- Am I seeking God's wisdom daily?
- Am I honoring God in my decisions?
- Am I showing kindness to others?
